This week in Year 4

Monday 15th June

English:

This week in English the children will be writing a story based on a short video that they will watch called *The Lighthouse*. The children will plan their story, to include an introduction, a beginning, a problem and a resolution. They will write their story, ensuring that they are including exciting vocabulary to engage the reader, paragraphs and using a consistent tense throughout. Once finished, they will edit and make improvements.

Maths:

This week, we continue our unit on money. The children will use the fact that £1 = 100p to compare amounts of money and then they will add, subtract and multiply amounts of money.

The children will bring home their spellings on **Wednesday 17th June**. The focus this week: To identify and use words with the prefix inter. The children will be tested on **Monday 22nd June**.

Reading:

Please ensure your child is reading to an adult **daily** and they are being questioned about what they have read. Please record their reading in their reading record book. The children can change their books regularly if an adult has recorded in the book that they have read and finished the book. Children need to bring their reading book and reading record in to school every day.

Times Tables:

All the children completed the MTC last week, but they still need to continue working on recalling all the times tables up to 12x so they should still be accessing TTRS at least 3 times a week. There will not be a times table test as I would like children to learn their lines for the production.

Year 4 production – We will continue with our rehearsals for our Year 4 production. The children also have the songs for the production, that we are learning in class. The songs are available to stream on all major platforms, including Spotify, Apple and Amazon music. Simply search each song by its title and by artist 'Edgy Productions'.

The children are doing amazingly well with learning their lines. From **Monday 15th June** we would like all children to know most of their lines off by heart so we can rehearse without scripts. This then allows the children to start acting and using props. Please support them with helping them to learn their lines so they say them clearly and loudly. Thank you.

Other Matters:

- The children will have their PE lesson on **Wednesdays and Fridays**, they will need to remember to come to school in their PE kit on those days.
- Please can you ensure your child has the correct equipment in their pencil case – they must have writing pencils, 30cm ruler, whiteboard pens and a glue stick. – thank you.
- The children can bring in a handwriting pen to use in class. It must be blue ink, not a biro please.
