This week in Year 4

Monday 18th May 2026

English:

This week we continue our recount based on our residential trip to High Ashurst. The children will try to include fronted adverbials, a range of conjunctions and write their recount in chronological order. They will then edit and improve their work, using their success criteria to check their work.

Maths:

This week we are continuing our unit on Decimals. The children will be partitioning numbers with decimals up to 2 decimal places and then extend this to include flexible partitioning. They will then compare decimal numbers with up to 2 decimal places.

Home Learning:

Spellings:

The focus this week: **To learn Year 3 and 4 Statutory Words.**

The children brought home their spellings on **Wednesday 6th May** and will be tested on **Monday 18th May**.

Please ensure your child has their spelling book in school on a **Monday** so we can highlight any words spelt incorrectly in the spelling test and stick the new spellings in. The children's times table score is also recorded in the back of the spelling book.

Reading:

Please ensure your child is reading to an adult **daily** and they are being questioned about what they have read. Please record their reading in their reading record book. The children can change their books regularly if an adult has recorded in the book that they have read and finished the book. Children need to bring their reading book and reading record in to school every day.

Times Tables:

The children will be tested on all the times tables on **Tuesday 19th May**.

Children must be accessing Times Table Rock Stars at least 3 times a week to help them to learn the times tables. In addition, children may also want to use [Multiplication Tables Check - Mathsframe](#) or [Times tables games - Learn them all here!](#)
