This week in Year 4

Tuesday 22nd April 2025

English:

This week we will start with the children writing a recount of their Easter holidays. The children will be using fronted adverbials and a range of conjunctions to tell me about their Easter holiday. We will then continue with our unit on Fiction and Non-Fiction texts all about Wolves. The children will also be exploring the purpose of illustrations in non-fiction books.

Spellings:

This week's spellings will be their Star spellings. The children will receive their spellings on Tuesday 22nd April, and will be tested on Monday 28th April.

Maths:

This week we continue our unit on Fractions. The children will be developing a deeper understanding of how mixed numbers are represented on a number line. They will then compare mixed numbers where the whole number is different, recognising that the greater the whole number, the greater the mixed number.

Homework:

Homework will be sent out on Wednesdays and needs to be returned to school by the following Monday. This week's homework will include a writing activity and a Maths activity. There will be further information given with regards to your child's homework on Wednesday.

Please ensure, by Tuesday 22nd April, your child has learnt the words to the Easter song that they were given before the Easter holidays.
