Monday 23rd September 2024

English:

This week we are continuing with our Poetry unit (Imagery) and looking at animal poems. We will also be reading and discussing poems about colour and writing imagery about colour. We will be understanding what a conjunction is and identifying the difference between subordinating conjunctions and coordinating conjunctions. We will continue to read our class book 'Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone'.

Maths:

This week we continue with comparing and ordering numbers 10,000. The children will also be introduced to Roman numerals, then rounding to the nearest 10 and 100. Spellings:

The focus this week is to add the prefix im- (before a root word starting with 'm' or 'p'); immature, immeasurable, impossible, immortal, imperfect, impatient, immovable, impolite, important and improper. Year 4's spelling test will be on Monday 30th September. I sent home a copy of the spelling words for this first half term, please feel free to remove this document from your child's homework file and keep it somewhere safe at home!

Homework:

Homework will be sent out on Wednesdays and needs to be returned to school by the following Monday. I have spoken to the children about this and have suggested ways in which they can organise their time to ensure their homework is handed in on time. This week's homework will include an English activity, a Mathematics activity and handwriting/spelling sheet. There will be further information given with regards to your child's homework on Wednesday.
