This week in Year 4

Monday 25th September 2023

English:

This week we will start our new unit, Fiction (fantasy), with a focus on the book, 'Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone. We have already started reading the book in class, we have read up to chapter 3. This week we will focus on identifying conjunctions, and the difference between subordinating conjunctions and coordinating conjunctions. We will also create powerful sentences, to include similes.

Spellings:

The focus this week is to **add the prefix im- (before a root word starting with 'm' or 'p');** immature, immeasurable, impossible, immortal, imperfect, impatient, immovable, impolite, important and improper. Year 4's spelling test will be on Monday 2nd October 2023. I sent home a copy of the spelling words for this first half term, please feel free to remove this document from your child's homework file and keep it somewhere safe at home!

Maths:

This will be our final week of place value. The children will start the week by learning the roman numerals, then the main focus will be on rounding. In year 4 children are expected to be able to round any number to the nearest 10, 100, and 1000. Homework:
