English:

This week we will continue with our new unit, 'Myths and Legends' with a focus on legends of the sea. In this unit your child will listen to mythical stories of selkies and mermaids. This week children will spend time planning a new version of, 'Can you catch a mermaid?'. We will focus on including; dialogue and paragraphs. The children will write a draft version and then a final version to place in the class book corner.

Spellings:

The focus this week is nouns ending in the suffix -ation; information, adoration, sensation, preparation, education, location, exaggeration, concentration, imagination, and organisation. Year 4's spelling test will be on Monday 5thFebruary 2024. If your child has returned home with a different spelling list, please focus on those words and not the ones mentioned above.

Maths:

This week we will be continuing with our new unit, 'Multiplication and Division B. We will start the week by learning how to Multiply 2-digit and 3-digit numbers by a 1-digit number using formal written layout. To recall multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to 12×12 and use place value, known and derived facts to multiply and divide mentally, including: multiplying by 0 and 1; dividing by 1; multiplying together 3 numbers.

Homework:

Homework will be sent out on Wednesdays and needs to be returned to school by the following Monday. I have spoken to the children about this and have suggested ways in which they can organise their time to ensure their homework is handed in on time. This week's homework will include an English activity, and a Mathematics activity. There will be further information given with regards to your child's homework on Wednesday.

Other Matters:

- Swimming has now finished.
- The children voted to read, 'The Last Bear' written by Hannah Gold. We will start reading it in class from Monday 8th January 2023. Please encourage your child to finish reading their Harry Potter book at home, if they haven't finished reading it.
- The children will have their PE lesson on Tuesdays and Fridays, they will need to remember to bring their PE kit in on those days.
- Please encourage your child to read daily at home and sign their reading record, I have informed the children that I will be checking their reading records every Friday.
