# This week in Year 4

### English:

This week we are continuing our work on using expanded noun phrases, powerful verbs and adverbs in our writing. We are continuing to read our class book 'Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone'. We are just about to start Chapter 4.

### Maths:

After learning about Roman Numerals, comparing and ordering numbers to 10,000 last week, our main focus this week will be on rounding. In year 4 children are expected to be able to round any number to the nearest 10, 100, and 1000. #### Homework:
