This week in Year 4

Monday 4th December 2023

English:

This week we will continue with our Harry Potter unit, we will have our Harry Potter Day on Monday 4th December. The children started planning their own character descriptions last week, thinking about their character in Harry Potter and The Philosopher's Stone. This is all in preparation for the children to write their own magical stories this week.

Spellings:

The focus this week is words with 'ough' to make a long /o/, /oo/ or /or/ sound; though, although, dough, through, breakthrough, thought, bought, brought, fought, and ought. Year 4's spelling test will be on Monday 4th December 2023. If your child has returned home with a different spelling list, please focus on those words and not the ones mentioned above.

Maths:

This week we will continue with our Multiplication and Division unit. Building on the previous step, children build on their knowledge of the 1 and 10 times-tables to explore the 11 times-table. Children explore the effect of multiplying by 1. They notice that when they multiply a number by 1, the result will always be the number itself. This small step also focuses on multiplying by zero. Children learn that when multiplying any number by zero the result is always zero.

Homework:

Homework will be sent out on Wednesdays and needs to be returned to school by the following Monday. I have spoken to the children about this and have suggested ways in which they can organise their time to ensure their homework is handed in on time. This week's homework will include an English activity, and a Mathematics activity. There will be further information given with regards to your child's homework on Wednesday.
