Monday 6th October 2025

English:

This week we will continue with our Poetry unit (Imagery). We will be writing our own poems. The children will write a descriptive poem about an animal, using similes, adjectives, and rhythm. They will choose an animal and describe its appearance, movement, and sounds.

Spellings:

Children will get their spelling words on **Wednesday 8th October** to learn for **Monday 13th October**. The children will be focusing on the long I phoneme.

Maths:

Last week we continued with our 'Place Value' unit. The children will continue rounding numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000. The children will then build on their knowledge of Roman numerals from 1 to 12 on a clock face, and learn that L represents 50 and C represents 100. The children will then move on to the 'Addition and subtraction' unit, where they will add and subtract 1s, 10s, 100s and 1,000s.

Homework:

Homework will be sent out on Wednesdays and needs to be returned to school by the following Monday. This week's homework will include an English activity and a Mathematics activity.

The children will come home on **Wednesday 8th October** with a new times table to learn for **Tuesday 14th October**.
