

Year 1 Reading Key Objectives

Narrative - Reading - Comprehension
I can read a story with my teacher picking out key aspects
I can identify and discuss the title and key events
I can show I understand what has been read to me
I can draw on what I already know
I can draw on information given by my teacher
I can make inferences
I can predict what might happen
Non fiction - Reading - Comprehension
I know what lists, labels and captions are
I can identify instructions
I can use a dictionary
I can use reading skills to find the information I need
I can read information texts and find the answers to questions
I can identify fiction and non fiction books
Poetry - Reading - Comprehension
I can read a poem
I can read a poem and identify where the writer talks about the senses
I can read or listen to poems finding out what they are about and joining in with repeated phrases

Year 1 Writing Key Objectives

Writing – Grammar and Punctuation
I can write sentences using full stops correctly
I can write sentences using capital letters at the beginning correctly
I can write sentences using capital letters correctly
I can join sentences
I can write questions and use question marks
Writing - Composition
I can write a story with characters and a setting
Writing – Non-Fiction Grammar and Punctuation
I can write sentences using singular and plural correctly
I can write sentences using verbs correctly
I can write sentences using the past tense:
I can write exclamations and use exclamation marks
I can use apostrophes in sentences correctly
Writing – Non- Fiction Composition
I can organise information
Writing – Poetry- Grammar and Punctuation
I can write lines that rhyme
I can use adjectives correctly
I can write a phrase in the present tense
Writing Transcription - Handwriting
Sit correctly at a table, holding a pencil comfortably and correctly
Form lower-case letters in the correct direction, starting and finishing in the right place

Year 1 Maths Key Objectives

Number and Place Value
I can count to 100 and beyond
I know the multiples of 2
I understand what more or less means when counting in 1s
I know the multiples of 10
I know the multiples of 5
I can write and understand numbers up to 100 and beyond
I understand what the word equals means
I can read and write all the numbers from 0 to 20 and beyond in words
I understand what the words equals, more than, less than, most, least, mean
Addition and Subtraction
I can add one-digit numbers to 20
I can subtract one-digit numbers to 20
I know my number bonds for the number 20
I can add by reading and writing number sentences
I can subtract by reading and writing number sentences
I can add one-digit numbers to two-digit numbers to 20
I can subtract one-digit numbers from two-digit numbers to 20
I can solve one step problems that involve addition and subtraction
Multiplication and division
I can solve one step problems that involve multiplication and division
Fractions
I know what a half is
I know what a quarter is
Measurement
I know language relating to dates
I can find sensible ways to measure objects and record my measurements
I can find ways to compare objects by measuring them
I can read the time in hours and half hours
I know the value of notes and coins
I can sequence events in order using language related to time
Geometry: Properties of shapes
I can recognise and name common 2D shapes
I can recognise and name common 3D shapes
Geometry: position, direction, motion
