English:

We are going to start our week off by writing about our half terms. Our focus will be on using full stops and capital letters correctly.

We are then going to focus on nouns and adjectives, making sure we understand the difference and can use both nouns and adjectives in our writing. We will be using adjectives to describe some autumn objects.

Phonics:

This half term we are going to be focusing on phase 4 blends and clusters. This week we are going to look at the blends:

st, nd, mp, nt

The tricky words we will be learning this half term are:

said, have, like, so, do, some, come, little, one, were, out, what, when, there



Maths:

This week we are going to be working with numbers to 100 (beyond 100 if you child is able)

We will be ordering numbers, filling in missing numbers on a 10 square and working on 2 digit numbers. We will be making sure that we understand a 2 digit number is made up of tens and ones.



Homework:

Your child will bring home a reading book. They will be able to change their book once they have read it.

Please remember that purple homework folders come home on a Friday and need to be back in school by Wednesday. All work in the homework folder needs to be completed.

There is also online learning on abacus and purplemash. Please also remember that big club is available.

There is a spelling test every Friday. Please support your child with learning their words each week.
