Last week we wrote some instructions on how to plant seeds. This week we are going to be reading and following our instructions and planting our own seeds. We will also be focusing on capital letters and full stops as we are sometimes forgetting to use these when writing sentences!

Phonics:

We have now covered all alternative pronunciations and will be spending this week recapping what we have learnt.

We will be focusing on alien and real words as the phonic screening approaches, recapping phase 3, phase 4 and phase 5 sounds.



Maths:

This week we are going to be using the language of most/least and more/less. We will start off the week by estimating and putting amounts into order from least to most/most to least. We will then think about using the < > signs to show greater than and less than.



Homework:

Your child will bring home a reading book. They will be able to change their book once they have read it.

Please remember that purple homework folders come home on a Friday and need to be back in school by Wednesday. All work in the homework folder needs to be completed.

There is also online learning on abacus and purplemash. Please also remember that big club is available.

Your child will be tested on their star spellings on Monday.
