English:

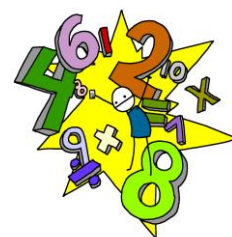
We are also going through our tricky words and using them in sentences:

Maths:

Last week Year 1 did a fantastic job at learning their number bonds to 10. This week we are going to be recapping number bonds to 10 and also learning our number bonds to 20.

We will be making sure we can write a number sentence correctly using the + and = symbols.



Homework:

Your child will bring home a reading book. They will be able to change their book once they have read it.
