This week we are going to be celebrating Space Week. Our activities are all going to be linked to space.



#### English:

We are going to start the week by looking at the story 'Look Up!' We will be learning some facts from the story and creating our own poster to advertise the meteor show. We will then be looking at the life of Mae Jemison and writing an information page about what we find out about her.

We will also look at the story 'Molly's Moon Mission.'

### **Phonics:**

We will be using monster phonics during our phonic lessons. This week we are looking at the sounds: ea and recapping sounds we have learnt so far

The words we are focusing on: down, now, look, looked, asked, could, saw, all

### Maths:

In maths this week we are going to be looking at 2D and 3D shapes thinking about the properties of shapes and recognising them. We will be building our own rockets using these shapes. We will also be doing some space themed adding and finding one more and one less.



### Homework:

Please read daily with your child. They are able to change their coloured book each day.

Monster phonic books get changed each Monday. Please make sure monster phonic books are kept in school bags so we can change them.
