### English:

This week we are going to continue to look at the story 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch.'

We will be thinking of a disgusting sandwich idea as Mrs Grinling needs our help to scare off the seagulls again. We will be drawing a picture of our sandwich and labelling it. We will also be thinking about the end of the story and what could happen next.

### Phonics:

This week we are looking at the sounds:

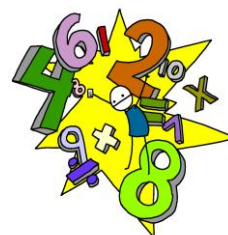
**oo, oo, oa**

### Maths:

This week we are going to be measuring. We will be measuring lengths using objects and then will be measuring in centimeters. We will be using a ruler to help us do this and will be measuring some objects around the classroom.



### Homework:

**Monster phonic books get changed each Monday.** Please make sure monster phonic books are kept in school bags so we can change them. Your child will also get to choose a free choice book that they can read for enjoyment. This book is a good book to be sharing at bedtime or at the weekend. They can also change this book on a **Monday**.

We would like children to read at least 5 times a week with an adult.

The phonic screening is taking place this week. The children will be reading 20 real words and 20 alien words.

Your child will be tested on their spellings each Friday. Please support them with learning their spellings.
