This week we will be revising the sounds:

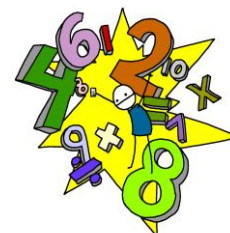

## Maths:

This week we are going to be continuing with our fraction topic and focusing on quarters. We will be cutting objects into quarters making sure we create 4 equal parts. We will then be splitting quantities into quarters and thinking about sharing into 4 groups. We will be doing this practically with counters first.
