English:

This week we are looking at the sounds:

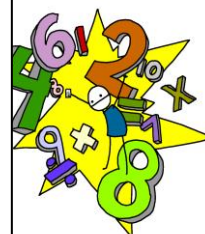
We are going to be revising ir, ur, oo, and looking at real and nonsense words in preparation for the phonic screening.

Maths:

This week we are going to begin to look at mass and volume. We will be using the language of heavier and lighter. We will use balance scales to compare objects. We will then use a variety of non-standard units, such as cubes or bricks, to measure the mass of an object.



Homework:

Homework comes home on a Friday and needs to be handed in the following Friday.
