English:

This week we are going to be thinking about the Julia Donaldson books we have looked at and do a class vote to find out our favourite. We will be writing a book review on our favourite Julia Donaldson book.

We will be then be looking at non-fiction books and using non-fiction books to find out information.

Phonics:

We will be using monster phonics during our phonic lessons.

Phonics ee ur ow wh y au

Maths:

This week we are going to begin to look at addition to 20. We will start by adding by counting on and adding ones using number bonds. We will then be finding and making number bonds to 20.



Homework:

Monster phonic books get changed each Monday. Please make sure monster phonic books are kept in school bags so we can change them.

Homework comes home on Friday and needs to be handed in on Wednesday. **There is no homework over half term.**

Your child will be tested on their star spellings on **Monday 10th February.** They will come home with new star spelling words for the next half term. Your child may need to relearn the same words.
