English:

Phonics:

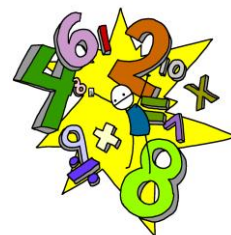
We are also going through our tricky words and using them in sentences:

Maths:

This week we are going to be looking at doubling numbers. We will begin with working with doubles for numbers up to 10 and then for numbers up to 20.

We will be using practical resources, number lines and 100 squares to help us.
