English:

This week we are going to be focusing on nouns and adjectives. We will be making sure we can identify the difference and use both of them correctly in sentences. We will be writing descriptive noun phrases using autumn objects and preparing for our poem writing by writing a list of things we would experience on an autumn walk eg crunchy leaves, hard conkers etc

Phonics:

We will be using monster phonics during our phonic lessons. This week we are looking at the sounds:

er, ir, ur

The words we are focusing on: Mr, Mrs, what, their, little, called



Maths:

In maths this week we are going to be adding. It is important when we are adding we use the correct language of 'plus' and 'is equal to.' " 5 plus 3 is equal to 8"

We are going to be solving some word problems that involve addition and creating some of our own.



Homework:

Please read daily with your child. They are able to change their coloured book each day.

Monster phonic books get changed each Monday. Please make sure monster phonic books are kept in school bags so we can change them.

Homework comes home on Friday and needs to be handed in on Wednesday.

Your child will be tested on their spellings each Friday. Please support them with learning their spellings.

Please support your child with their star spellings this half term. They will be tested just before the Christmas break.
