This week we are going to start phase 5b which will look at alternative pronunciations. We will look this week at the different pronunciations for, o, c, g, u

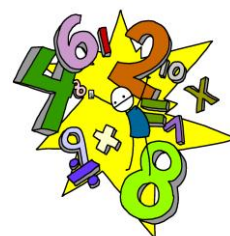
The tricky words we are focusing on this week are:

We will be using resources in our classroom such as cubes and counters to help us do our sharing.



Homework:

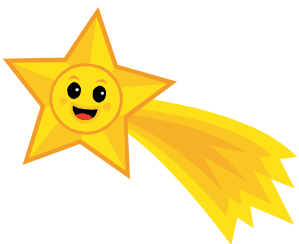
Your child will bring home a reading book. They will be able to change their book once they have read it.
