We will be using monster phonics during our phonic lessons.

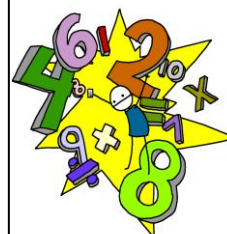
This week we are going to be looking at compound words, how to write numbers as words and contractions.
