English:

This week we are going to be thinking about the end of part of the Lighthouse Keeper's lunch. We will be thinking of our own ideas about what could happen next. We will then be writing our own story which includes the seagulls and what cheeky thing they get up to!

Phonics:

We will be using monster phonics during our phonic lessons. This week we are looking at the sounds:

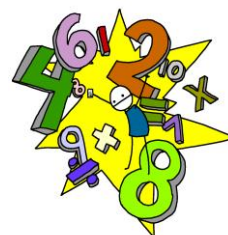
ore, aw, au

Maths:

This week we are going to be looking at mass and volume. We will introduce to mass for the first time. They may have some understanding of describing something as heavy or light from their own experience. Children begin by holding objects to compare them, using the language of "heavier" or "lighter". They then use balance scales to check their comparisons.



Homework:

Monster phonic books get changed each Monday. Please make sure monster phonic books are kept in school bags so we can change them. Your child will also get to choose a free choice book that they can read for enjoyment. This book is a good book to be sharing at bedtime or at the weekend. They can also change this book on a **Monday**.

We would like children to read at least 5 times a week with an adult.

Your child will be tested on their spellings each Friday. Please support them with learning their spellings.

Please can you practice sentence writing at home with a focus on capital letters and full stops. We really want to send them to Year 2 confidently using both of these.



Action Points:

- ★ Our PE days are **Tuesday and Friday**. Please ensure your child wears their PE kit on these days.
- ★ Please make sure your child's reading books and diary is in their bag each day. Monster phonic books **are changed every Monday** and **class library books can also be changed on a Monday**. Your child is unable to choose a new book until they have brought theirs in.
- ★ **On Monday 15th June we will be making binoculars as part of our Science lesson. Please can your child bring in two toilet roll tubes with them for this activity.**
- ★ **Sports Day is 18th June.** Your child needs to be dropped at Stovell field at 8.45am. They only need their water bottle. We will provide a snack when we are back at school.
