### **English:**

This week we are going to be reading and looking at different poems. We will focus on autumn poems and poems that use the senses.

We are going to be planning to write our own autumn sense poems thinking about what we hear, see, feel, smell and taste during autumn.

### **Phonics:**

This half term we are going to be focusing on phase 4 blends and clusters. This week we are going to look at the blends:

lp, lf, lk, pt

The tricky words we will be learning this half term are:

said, have, like, so, do, some, come, little, one, were, out, what, when, there



#### Maths:

This week we are going to continue to work on our addition skills and will be solving some word problems using our adding knowledge. We will then move on to subtraction. Making sure we are able to use the takeaway symbol correctly in our number sentences and understand that when we subtract we jump backwards on a 100 square as the number gets smaller.

Your child will bring home a reading book. They will be able to change their book once they have read it.
