Maths:

This week we are going to be looking at capacity. We will be using the language of full, half full, half empty, nearly empty, nearly full and empty. We will be putting containers in order thinking about which has the most and which has the least. We will then be doing our own experiment to find out which containers holds the most amount of water.
