This week in Year 1

English:

This week we are going to begin to look at the story 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch.' We will be listening to the story and ordering main events, thinking about our favourite part of the story. We will also be using drama to retell the story in groups.

Phonics:

We will be using monster phonics during our phonic lessons.

This week we are looking at the sounds:

We are going to be revising ir, ur, oo, and looking at real and nonsense words in preparation for the phonic screening.

The words we are focusing on: love, some, come, was, his, is, has, here, there, friend, your



Maths:

This week we are going to begin to be looking at capacity and volume. We will begin by exploring practically the idea that capacity is the maximum amount that something can hold. We will explore the concept that volume is the amount of something inside a container. They describe the volume in a container using phrases such as "empty", "nearly empty", "nearly full" and "full



Homework:

Please read daily with your child. They are able to change their coloured book each day.

Monster phonic books get changed each Monday. Please make sure monster phonic books are kept in school bags so we can change them.

Homework comes home on a Friday and needs to be handed in the following Wednesday.

Before half term you received spellings for this term. Pleas support your child with learning their words.

Your child came home with star spelling words to learn for this half term. They will be tested just before the Summer holidays.
