English:

The words we are focusing on: giant, find, laughed, again, friends, different, door, jumped, stopped

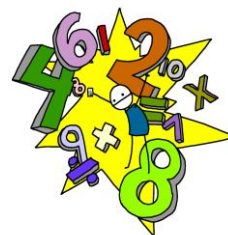

Maths:

This week we are going to be partitioning numbers into tens and ones and focusing on doing this for numbers up to 50.

We will also be counting by grouping objects into groups of 10.

We will then look at a number line to 50, making sure we can use it to count forwards and backwards and think of numbers which are one more and one less.
