English:

This week we are going to be learning about 2D shapes. We will be making sure we can recognise 2D shapes and can talking about their properties eg a square has 4 sides and 4 corners. We will be going on a shape hunt around school to see what shapes we can find and will be using 2d shapes to make pictures.
