

Monday 23rd June 2025



English:

This week we are going to begin to look at the story 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch.' We will be listening to the story and ordering main events, thinking about our favourite part of the story. We will also be using drama to retell the story in groups.

Phonics:

We will be using monster phonics during our phonic lessons. This week we are looking at the sounds: We are going to be revising oa, oe, ou, ow and looking at real and nonsense words in preparation for the phonic screening.

The words we are focusing on: the, said, of, house, our, one, once

Maths:

This week we are going to be counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. We will be practically exploring counting in 2s using things that come in pairs such as socks and wheels on a bicycle.

When counting in 10s we will use ten frames, bundles of straws, bead strings and number grids will reinforce children's understanding of the multiples of 10. We will also introduce some language related to multiplication.
