English:

We will continue to look at poems and autumn poems in particular, noticing patterns and spotting adjectives and rhyming words.

We will be completing a reading assessment activity this week, which focuses on the children's comprehension skills.

Phonics:

We will be using monster phonics during our phonic lessons.

This week we are looking at the sounds:

er/est suffixes and oe

The words we are focusing on: **more, horse, gone, live, would, school, soon, food, room**

Maths:

We are going to continue to look at our number bonds to 10, making sure we understand that a number bond is 2 numbers that go together to make 10.

We will also be doing a maths assessment activity to see what we have learnt so far in Year 1.



Homework:

Please read daily with your child. They are able to change their coloured book each day.

Monster phonic books are changed every Monday and your child will have that book for the week. Please make sure they have their reading wallet in their bag each day.

Homework can come home on Friday and needs to be handed in on Wednesday.

Your child will be tested on their spellings each Friday. Please support them with learning their spellings.
