English:

This week we are going to begin to look at the story 'Owl Babies.' We will be predicting what we think might happen in the story from the title and front cover. We will be ordering the main events in the story, using drama to retell the story and practising our caption writing skills.

Phonics:

We are recapping phase 3 sounds and this week we are going to be looking at the sounds:

oi, ear, air, ure, er

We are also going through our tricky words and using them in sentences: he, she, be, her, my, me, we, are, was, they, all, you

Phonics ee ur ow wh y au

Maths:

In maths this week we are going to be looking at our number bonds to 10 and then to 20. By the end of Year 1 we need to confidently recall our number bonds to 10 and to 20.

We will be using the numicon to help us make our number bonds practically.



Homework:

Your child will bring home a reading book. They will be able to change their book once they have read it.

Your child came home with their homework folder on Friday. There was a sheet with their online learning logins, if you have any problems then please do email me. Homework must be handed in by Wednesday.
