English:

We are going to continue our learning about 'Handa's Surprise.' We will be looking at nouns and adjectives in the story and writing our own descriptive sentences. We will also use drama to retell the story in groups.

Phonics:

We will be using monster phonics during our phonic lessons. This week we are looking at the sounds: **We are going to be revising oy,a-e, i-e, e-e** The words we are focusing on: thought, through, magic, narrator, once, air, I've, I'll, who, these

Maths:

This week we are looking at numbers up to 50. We are going to be partitioning numbers into tens and ones and using practical resources like the cubes to help us eg 41 is 4 tens and 1 one. We will also be working on our counting in tens.
