English:

This week we are going to be planning and writing our own seaside poem using our senses, thinking about what we can see, hear, feel, taste and touch.

We will be performing poems in groups, adding actions and learning how we say a poem with pace and rhythm.

Phonics:

We will be using monster phonics during our phonic lessons.

Y, wh, ph

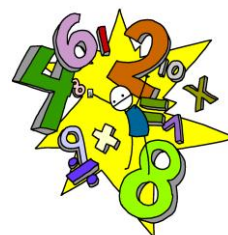
We will be looking at the words: **down, now, look, looked, asked, could, saw, all**

Maths:

This week we will be finishing our learning on capacity and volume.

We will be comparing the volume in different containers and using words such less than and greater than. We will be doing an investigation using containers around our classroom to find which container holds the most amount of cubes.



Homework:

Monster phonic books get changed each Monday. Please make sure monster phonic books are kept in school bags so we can change them. Your child will also get to choose a free choice book that they can read for enjoyment. This book is a good book to be sharing at bedtime or at the weekend. They can also change this book on a **Monday**.

We would like children to read at least 5 times a week with an adult.

Your child will be tested on their spellings each Friday. Please support them with learning their spellings.

Please can you practice sentence writing at home with a focus on capital letters and full stops. We really want to send them to Year 2 confidently using both of these.



Action Points:

- ★ Our PE days are **Tuesday and Friday**. Please ensure your child wears their PE kit on these days.
- ★ Please make sure your child's reading books and diary is in their bag each day. Monster phonic books **are changed every Monday** and **class library books can also be changed on a Monday**. Your child is unable to choose a new book until they have brought theirs in.
- ★ **On Monday we are making animal homes in our science lesson. Please bring in a bag of natural materials such as stones, leaves, moss, twigs etc. There is a letter explaining more.**
- ★ On Thursday 2nd July there is transition afternoon. We have been talking and preparing the children for Year 2 through our PSHE lessons.
