English:

Phonics:

We will also be exploring the Year 2 common exception words: even, people, whole and clothes and the high frequency words: over, most, going, cold, told, love, something and dragon.

Maths:

This week we will be concluding our unit on multiplication and division, revising what we have learnt in this unit.

Home learning:

Reading – We would be grateful if you could check to see whether you have any previously issued Monster Phonics books at home as we are finding that some sets are missing books. Thank you.

Please ensure that your child brings their Monster Phonics book **AND** reading record with them to school on a Monday so that it can be swapped for their new book.

A reminder to also ensure you make a note in your child's reading record of when they have read to you or vice versa and that we will be rewarding those children who have read with an adult five times in the week (Monday to Monday) with a golden point.
