
English:

The children will be writing extended sentences using coordinating conjunctions. They will need to ensure that their two clauses link together and they have the punctuation in the correct places.

Phonics:

Maths:

This week we will be continuing our learning on money. The children will be looking at comparing different amounts of money and calculating change.
