Year 3

We will be starting to read Me and Mister P by Maria Ferrer.

DT project. We will be making a model of an animal with a moving part using a pneumatic system. Please could your child collect a few cardboard packets to help create the animal. They are likely to need one larger box (such as a small cereal packet) and some smaller ones, eg jaffa cake/cheese biscuit/stock cube/toothpaste/kitchen roll tube (no loo roll inners though please). Please bring them in on the 19th or 22nd November.

Maths – In Maths this week we will complete work on 3D shapes before looking at subtraction using a number line to count on in jumps. I will post a video on Abacus so that you can see how we do this – we do not do column subtraction in Year 3.

English – We will finish our letters with a COP26 theme and start planning one more letter.

Spellings - This week the spelling patterns that we will look at are:

- Adding -ies to nouns and verbs ending in -y
- Adding the suffix '-ful',

Foundation – Trombone lessons will continue on Thursday and Mr Manners will join us for a singing session on Monday afternoon. We will continue to look at the River Nile in our History lesson. In PE we will be swimming on Wednesday, Mr Hawkes will teach us on Fridays and we will also have a session provided by the Windsor Sports Partnership about Healthy Minds on Wednesday afternoon. In RE we will complete our first look at the Sikh religion and will look at whether or not joining the Khalsa makes you a better Sikh. In Science we will finish our topic of light with an investigation into light. In our DT lesson we will be learning about pneumatic systems and making things move. Eventually we will use this to design and make our own moving model.
