#### Year 3

# Pencil case top-ups:

Children need safety scissors, black whiteboard pens, several HB pencils, a rubber and sharpener, a 30cm ruler, a glue stick and some colouring pencils. Thank you.

**Maths** – In Maths this week we are working on telling the time using digital and analogue clocks. This is a topic that needs lots of practice so please help them to do this at home as well.

**English** – This week we will be re-telling the story of Daedalus and Icarus and will be focussing on writing direct speech as well as our descriptive writing.

**Spellings** - This week the two spelling patterns that we will look at are:

- /zh/ sound spelt 's'
- Homophones or near homophones

**Foundation** – Trombone lessons will continue on Thursday and Mr Manners will join us for a singing session on Monday afternoon. In Geography we will complete our presentation about a rainforest animal. In PE we are looking forward to our final dance session provided by the Windsor Sports Partnership and 4Motion. In RE we are focusing on the Sikh religion and why wearing the 5k's is important for some Sikhs. In Science we will continue to investigate mirrors in our topic of light.

#### Homework

Spellings will come home on Friday and will be tested the following Friday. These are the weekly spellings based on a common pattern found in words.

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Phonic sound revision: this week we are revising the sounds -au and -ey. A login for espresso education has sent home. I will add some phonic games that can be played to help with recognising these sounds.
