# This week in Year 4

# Monday 29th April 2024

### English:

We will continue with our 'Performance Poetry' unit. The children had a great time learning, and then performing their poems last week. They remembered the performance advise and tips that we discussed the previous week. This week, the children will focus on creating their own poems, to include abstract nouns and phrases.

### Spellings:

This week we will focus on words that add the prefix auto- (meaning 'self'); autograph, autobiography, automatic, autofocus, autocorrect, autopilot, autopsy, automobile, autonomy, and autocue. These spellings can be found in your child's homework folder. The children will be tested on Monday (6.05.24). If your child has returned home with a different spelling list, please focus on those words and not the ones mentioned above.

#### Maths:

This week we will continue with our 'Shape' unit. Children will compare and classify geometric shapes, including quadrilaterals and triangles, based on their properties and sizes. Next, they will Identify lines of symmetry in 2-D shapes presented in different orientations. We are also hoping to complete a simple symmetric figure with respect to a specific line of symmetry.

#### Homework:

Homework will be sent out on Wednesdays and needs to be returned to school by the following Monday. I have spoken to the children about this and have suggested ways in which they can organise their time to ensure their homework is handed in on time. This week's homework will include an English activity, and a Mathematics activity.
