### **Year 4**

**Maths** – In Maths this week we will finish off our problem solving work linked to addition and subtraction before moving on to our methods for multiplication and division. Initially we will look at mental methods and what happens if we divide and multiply by 1 and 0. From this we will move to doubling and halving and multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000. Each morning we start the day with a timestables activity.

**English** – In English the children will write a short piece linked to their Geography work. The children will be encouraged to demonstrate: powerful verbs, adverbs, noun phrases and fronted adverbials. Towards the end of the week we will start our persuasive writing. There will also be some reading comprehension work this week.

### **Foundation**

In Geography we will look at different types of settlement. The children will be describing a place they have visited on holiday or somewhere a member of the family lives. They will be asked to describe the buildings in the settlement to try and work out what kind of settlement it is. In RE we will continue to investigate aspects of Judaism with a focus on the Jewish Home. Having observed melting 'ice hands' this week, the children will be planning experiments linked to solids and liquids and changing state.
