# This week in Year 4

# Monday 6<sup>th</sup> May 2024

### English:

The children spent last week planning, writing, editing and then using Word to type up their independent poems. I was so impressed with the quality of the children's poems, and I hope you enjoyed reading it. This week we will start our fiction unit, introducing, 'The Butterfly Lion' written by Michael Morpurgo. We will start the week by reading chapters 1-4, then we will role play a conversation between Bertie and his father.

#### Spellings:

This week we will focus on words that add the prefix auto- (meaning 'self' or 'own'); autograph, autobiography, automatic, autofocus, autocorrect, autopilot, autopsy, automobile, autonomy, and autocue. These spellings can be found in your child's homework folder. The children will be tested on Tuesday (7.05.24). If your child has returned home with a different spelling list, please focus on those words and not the ones mentioned above.

#### Maths:

This week we will start our 'Position and Direction' unit. Children are introduced to coordinate grids and begin to describe the positions of points on a grid. We will also learn that the x-axis is horizontal and the y-axis is vertical. Next the children will use their understanding from the previous lesson to plot points with given coordinates on a grid. Children gain more experience of reading and plotting points by drawing 2-D shapes on a coordinate grid towards the end of the week.

#### Homework:

Homework will be sent out on Wednesdays and needs to be returned to school by the following Monday. I have spoken to the children about this and have suggested ways in which they can organise their time to ensure their homework is handed in on time. This week's homework will include an English activity, and a Mathematics activity. There is a big focus on the children learning their times tables this term, please encourage your child to go onto times tables rock stars as often as possible; <u>https://ttrockstars.com/</u>
