This week in Year 4

Monday 8th July 2024

English:

This week the children will be writing a new chapter for, 'The Butterfly Lion'. The children made a plan last week and are eager to start writing their own chapter. The children will have a check list and will need to include; dialogue, different sentence openers, a variety of punctuation, build up, problem, resolution, and similes. They will work on editing their work and typing a final version.

Spellings:

The test for the star spelling words will be this week. This week we will focus on adverbials of frequency and possibility: regularly, occasionally, frequently, usually, rarely, perhaps, maybe, certainly, possibly, and probably. The children will be tested on Monday (15.07.24). If your child has returned home with a different spelling list, please focus on those words and not the ones mentioned above.

Maths:

This week we will continue with our, 'Decimals' unit. The children will explore hundredths as decimals. They will continue to explore hundredths as decimals by looking at the hundredths column in a place value chart. Next, the children will divide a 1-digit number by 10 and 100, resulting in a decimal number with 1 decimal place or 2 decimal places. This week we will complete our decimals unit and move on to a new unit. Please continue to complete TTRS three times a week.

Homework:

This week the children will be thinking about their memories at first school. Please help your child to complete their memories homework, thinking about exciting things that have happened each year. The children will share a memory at the Leavers' Service, which is on Tuesday 23rd July 2024. Your child should continue to read daily and complete their reading record.
