

Quarterly Assessment weeks and Reporting timescales

These dates and deadlines are common to all schools in the Twyford Trust.

After each assessment point, time is needed for teachers to mark assessments and give feedback to students in class. We aim to publish results and accompanying gradesheets/reports on Go4Schools as soon as possible after the assessment deadline for teachers.

At Christmas (Q2) and Easter (Q3) we prioritise some year groups to be completed before the holiday, and some are then completed shortly after the holiday.

Reporting

Each quarterly grade sheet contains this information.

One quarter each year, a form tutor and a senior teacher (HOY/AHOY/SLT) also write written comments for some year groups.

Target grades based on prior attainment and expected progression rates

Current grades show results in recent assessments. For subjects with target grades, these are shaded depending whether the grade is 'On Track' or not at this stage of the year.

On Track? shows if the student is currently making the progress we expect in order to meet or exceed their target grade **by the end of the year**.

We only record On Track for subjects with target grades.

The colouring shows if the grade is On Track or not.

Purple The current grade is **on track** and is currently above the end of year target

Green The current grade is **on track** and is currently at or just below the end of year target (but in reach of it by the end of the year)

Yellow The current grade is **off track** but is only 1 grade below on track

Red The current grade is **off track** and is 2 or more grades below on track

Learning Habit grades are given for classwork, homework and memorisation.
1 = Consistently engaged
2 = Usually engaged
3 = Not engaged

Conduct/Attendance/Punctuality summary sheets for Years 7-11 are emailed directly to parents at the end of each quarter.

Wider learning summaries for Years 7-11 are also produced and emailed home to parents.

Assessment and Reporting at each quarter

Quarter 2 and Quarter 4 are the most significant assessment points with formal assessment weeks with cumulative content assessed. All subjects assess in these weeks.

Quarter 1 and Quarter 3 are 'lighter touch' assessment points, particularly at KS3. The tables below give detail of which subjects assess in these quarters.

Quarter 3 is a final mock exam for Year 11 and 13 ahead of their GCSE and A Level exams.

In most cases these formal assessments are marked and graded. The overall 'current grade' shows on the gradesheet. By comparing with their target grades, students can see if they are 'on track' or not to meet their end of year target.

There are some lighter touch assessments (eg. lower school humanities in Q1 and Q3) which give a mark only. We sometimes call these "**milestone markers**". The mark or percentage score shows on Go4Schools, but does not transfer to the gradesheet. As well as feedback and reflection tasks after the assessment, teachers should routinely share the context of these scores (eg. the max and min marks in their class, and the average score in their class).
