How to Apply: The Common Application Form (CAF)

The Common Application Form (CAF), also referred to as the common Pan-London application form, must be submitted to your Local Authority.

Tie Break Criteria

- **Sibling priority** – applicants with siblings enrolled at Twyford at the point of application and who will be attending school at Twyford in September (with the exception of Year 13 students), with distance criteria applied (“sibling refers to all blood, half, step, adoptive and foster children who live at the same home address as the child already attending the school and will be attending the school at the time of the sibling’s attendance)
- **Ealing Deanery area** – applicants residing within the Ealing Deanery with distance criteria applied
- **Brent & Harrow Deanery areas** – applicants residing within either Brent or Harrow Deaneries with distance criteria applied
- **Hillingdon Deanery area** – applicants residing within Hillingdon Deanery with distance criteria applied
- Applicants residing outside of the aforementioned deaneries with **distance criteria** applied

What not to include with your Supplementary Information Form

Please do not send the following with your Supplementary Information Form:

- **Birth certificates or Proof of Address** – the Council does this via the Common Application Form and will confirm to the Schools
- **Evidence of Social or Medical cases** – Twyford is unable to consider any social or medical evidence (unless it is specifically evidence of 'Looked After' or 'Previously Looked After' status for the child applicant and/or 'Disability' status under the Equality Act for either the child applicant and/or the Parent/Carer)
- **Baptism, Confirmation certificates or a Catholic Certificate of Practice** – Twyford is only able to consider the Religious Reference as completed directly onto the application form

Specialist Music Scholar Admissions

- Applications are submitted electronically here: <https://twyfordacademies.org.uk/specialist-music-scholar-admissions-application-form> and parents and carers will receive an automated receipt for confirmation of submission. **The closing deadline for applications is Friday 2nd October by 4:00 PM.**
- All applicants will be invited to Round One of the music assessments. Musical Aptitude Testing will take place in the first week of October.
- Round Two of the assessments with the Music College take place in the second week of October.
- Notification of position on the Specialist Music Ranked List will be emailed to all parents and carers in the third week of October.
