BCLP Work Experience Programme 28th July – 8th August 2025 Open to Year 12 Students

BCLP's Career Kick Start Work Experience Programme is a two-week paid programme designed to provide Year 12 students with a detailed insight into what it's like to work in a City law firm. This year's programme will be taking place in person at our London office from 28 July to 8 August 2025.

Phase 1:

- Monday 28 July – Friday 1 August 2025 – A week at BCLP's offices gaining a real insight into what lawyers do on a daily basis, as well as information on the different routes into the profession and a number of skills sessions to help prepare students for the world of work.
- Monday 4 August – Friday 8 August 2025 – A week visiting a different organisation each day in a variety of sectors. During the week students will learn how law firms interact with their clients and the different roles for lawyers in these organisations. There will be plenty of opportunities to build their personal network and speak to people from all the different organisations involved.

Phase 2:

- On completion of the two weeks, students will progress onto BCLP's alumni programme where they will be able to get continued support from BCLP representatives including mentoring and further skills workshops

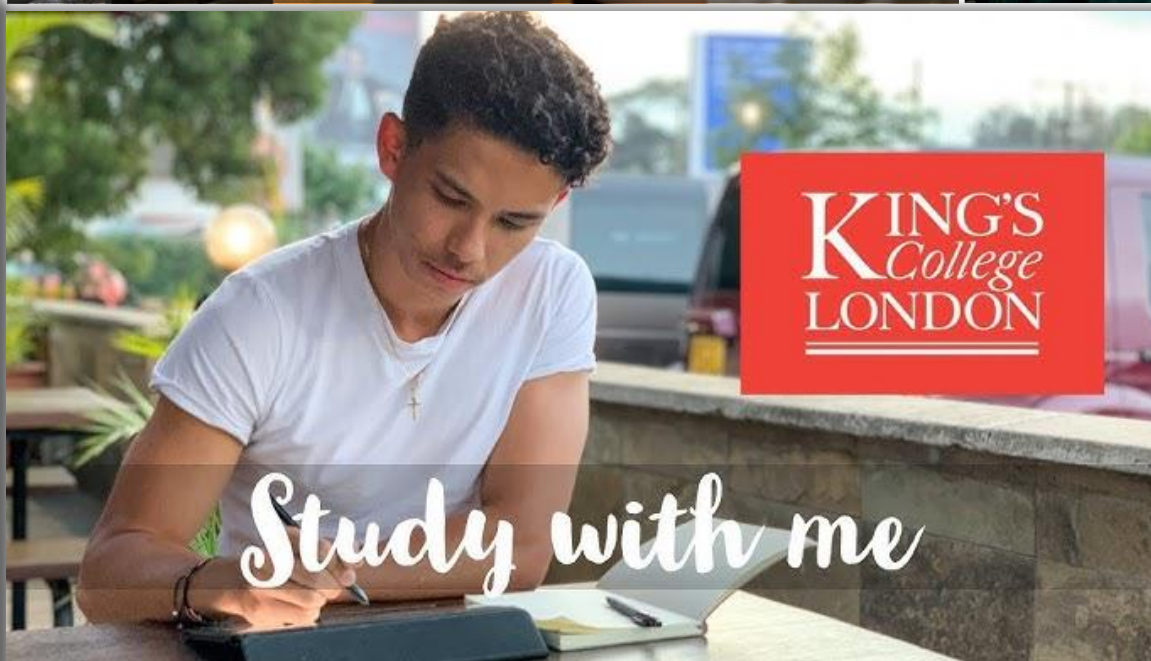

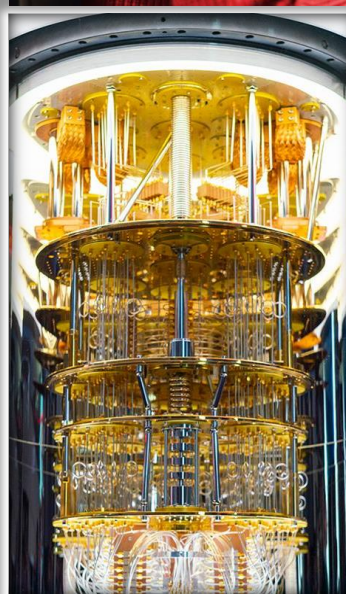
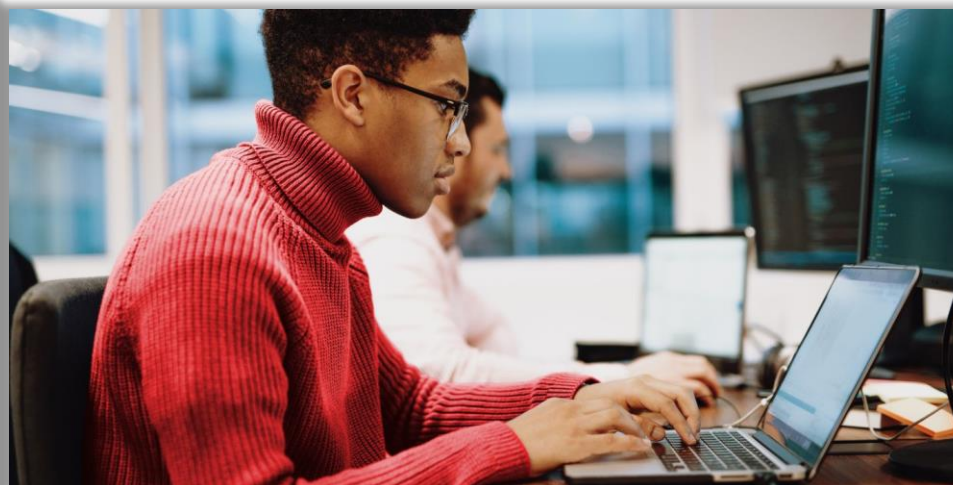
