This comprehensive taxonomy will serve as a resource for understanding the full spectrum and complexity of green skills required across various sectors, thereby enabling a cohesive approach toward achieving net zero and decarbonizing the global economy.


This established taxonomy serves as a foundational tool for aligning educational efforts, workforce development, and policy initiatives with the goals of a sustainable and resilient economy.

By 2030, there could be 694,000 green jobs in the low-carbon and renewable energy sector across England

MID GREEN OCCUPATION

A mid green occupation is where the principles of an occupation remain the same, but there is likely to be the need for significant new knowledge, skills and behaviours to be embedded to enable the use of new technologies and approaches.



LIGHT GREEN OCCUPATION

A light green occupation is one where the underlying intrinsic nature of the occupation is unchanged by sustainable/green requirements, but there may be additional duties that are done differently or in a consciously sustainable way.

DARK GREEN OCCUPATION

A dark green occupation would be one such as wind turbine engineer, which is intrinsically embedded within the green occupational map and delivering sustainable outcomes is inherent in the occupation. The impact of the occupation on net carbon zero goes beyond the way the individual carries out their duties.


