IBM

Twyford Careers Trips



OPEN TO SIXTH FORMERS



On Friday the 17th March, a group of year 12 students travelled into London, in order to visit the headquarters of IBM.

In the first half of our trip, we were shown several of IBM's past and current projects. These included the Mayflower 400, an autonomous ship designed to monitor levels of pollution in the seas, whilst navigating free of human control across the Atlantic. We also saw a model of one of IBM's quantum computers, the cutting edge of computing technology, in which IBM is one of the world leaders. Finally, we were shown Boston Dynamics' Spot, a robot dog, and a favourite of the group, equipped with sensors allowing it to perform tasks in spaces too dangerous for humans to work in.

During the second half of our trip, we took part in an assessment centre, which was designed to simulate a job interview-like activity. The 'candidates' attempted to solve a puzzle, whilst 'assessors' monitored progress. This was a unique experience, which enabled us to explore and develop skills that employers value. We were also introduced to Skillsbuild, an online platform, that allows you to complete tasks, and earn badges, that employers recognise as qualifications. These courses, ranging from science and tech to AI and project management, help to build up your skills, particularly in IBM's competencies, such as passion for business and communication. Overall the trip was a great success, and we look forward to IBM's coming assembly.

STEP 2

Finding Placements

Year 10 students should apply directly to places of work by sending their CV and a Cover Letter (please remember to cc-in CIAG@twyford.ealing.sch.uk)

*If you are struggling to find a placement, please email us at CIAG@twyford.ealing.sch.uk – we have already begun matching students with contacts from our database; please allow time for us to match you with the closest placement possible to your interest **(this can take up to a few weeks – all placements will be allocated by May)***

STEP 3

Completing the Consent Form

Once a placement is agreed, Parents & Carers will need to complete [the consent form](#) for Work Experience by 21st April

For students who are awaiting matching by the CIAG Department, there will be an extension to the first week in May for completion of this form

STEP 4

Insurance & Waivers

*We **MUST** have an up-to-date employers liability insurance for your placement before you attend in July – we will chase these with your employers but will notify your parent/carer if we don't receive it closer to the time*

It is possible to circulate a Waiver form in place of the liability insurance which must be reviewed by a parent/carer if students are keen on a placement


