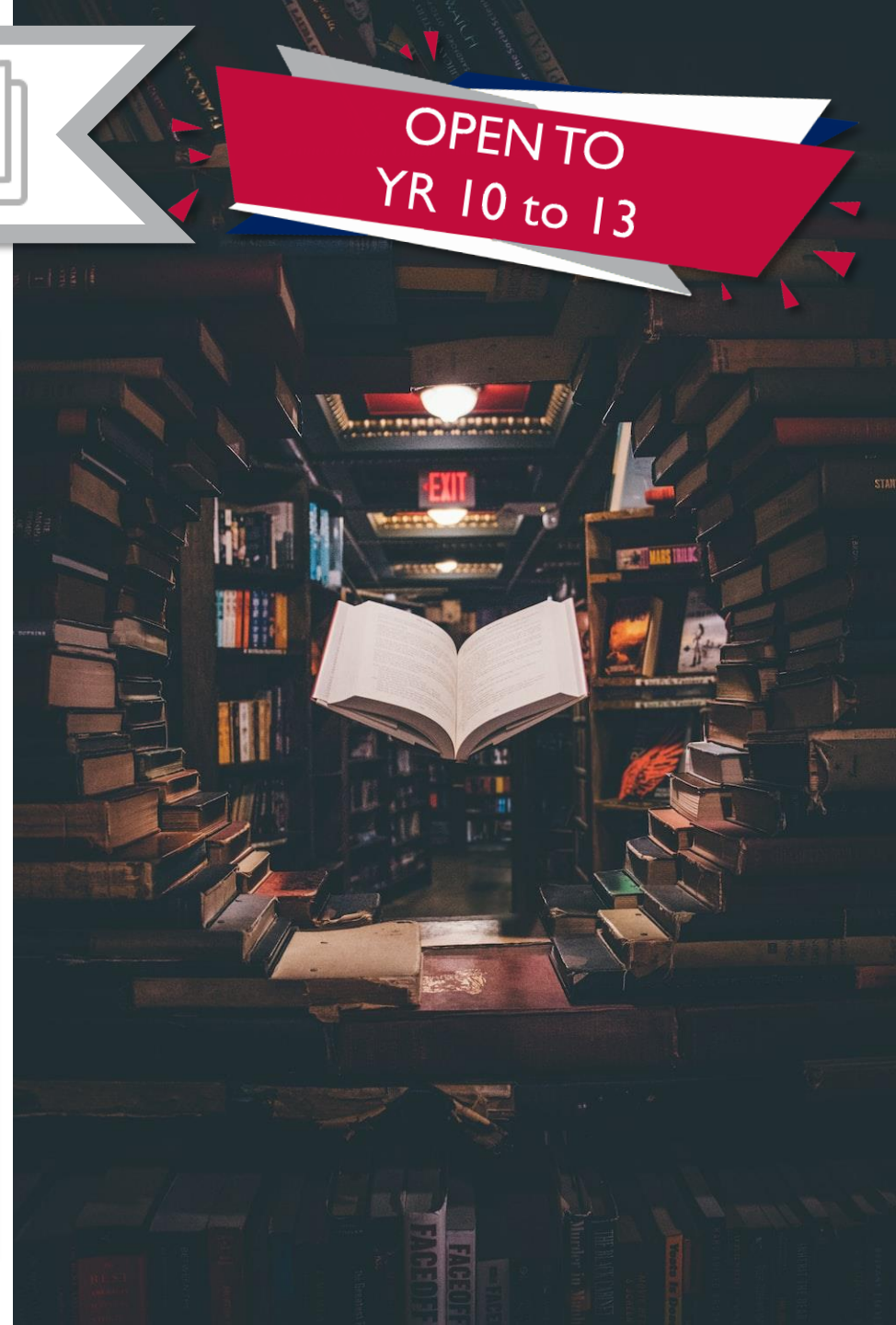

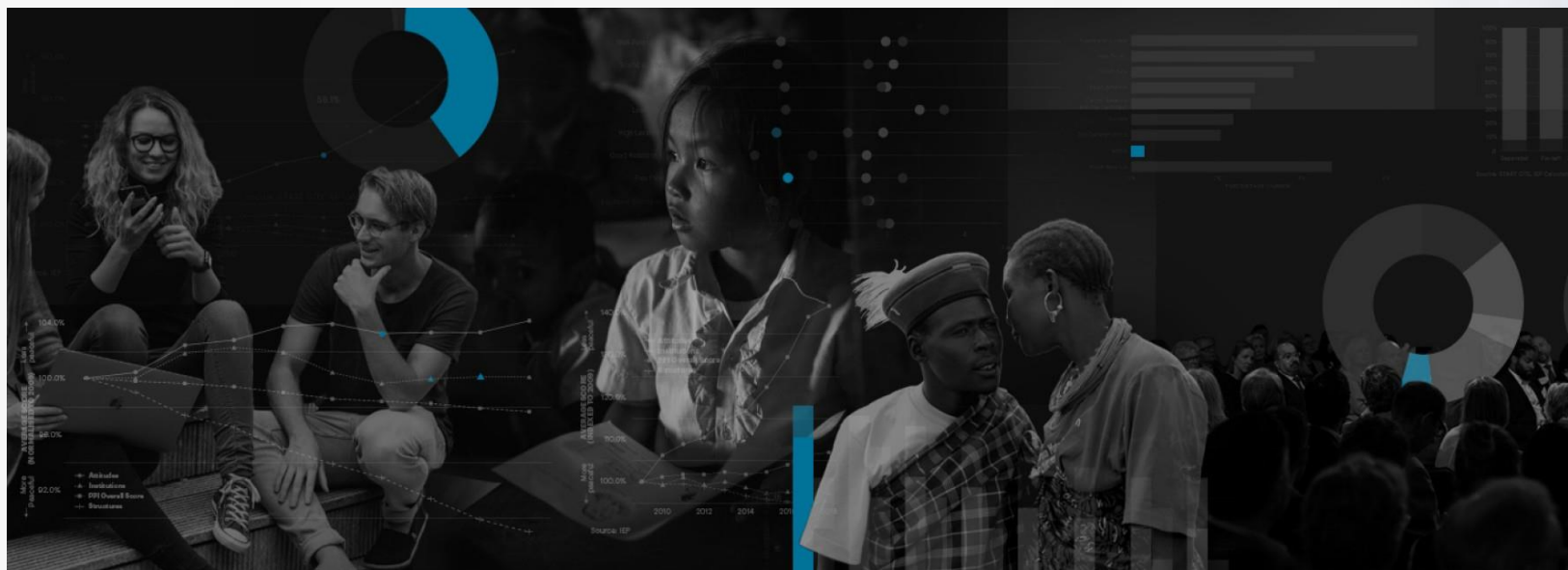

Verbal Reasoning

This subtest evaluates your logical thinking skills by assessing your ability to critically evaluate information that is presented in a written form.

Decision Making

This subtest assesses your ability to apply logic to reach a decision or conclusion, evaluate arguments and analyse statistical information.

Quantitative Reasoning

This subtest further evaluates your logical thinking skills by assessing your ability to critically evaluate information that is presented in numerical form.

Abstract Reasoning

This subtest assesses the use of convergent and divergent thinking to infer relationships from information.

Situational Judgement Test

This part of the test measures your capacity to understand real world situations and to identify critical factors and appropriate behaviour in dealing with them. The subtest focuses on integrity, perspective taking, both inductive, resistance and adaptability, which research has shown are important in clinical work in medicine and dentistry.
