| 1. condom | A. Can be used with a diaphragm to increase it's effectiveness and kill sperm. |
| 2. diaphragm | B. Used with a spermicidal cream, it acts as a barrier in the vagina to prevent sperm from entering the uterus. |
| 3. spermicidal cream | C. Provides a barrier inside the vagina which stops any sperm from entering the uterus. |
| 4. cap | D. Identifying when ovulation takes place using temperature checks and using this information to decide when it is safe to have sex. |
| 5. natural family planning | E. Provides a barrier to sperm so they are unable to enter the vagina and fertilise the egg. |
