Annotations are written explanations or *critical* comments, added to **art** or **design** work, that record and communicate your thoughts.

There are several reasons **annotation** may be used, for example to: *analyse* the work of an inspirational **artist** or **designer**, to analyse the success of a *technique*, idea or *composition*.

Critical – In this case, it means a way of explaining what you have created and why.
