The cost of the damage was estimated to be around US\$5 billion	An avalanche was triggered on Mount Everest killing 19 people	Almost three million people were made homeless
Landslides occurred along steep valleys. 250 people were killed when the village of Ghodatabela was covered in material.	8692 people died and approximately 20000 were injured	People were evacuated due to the risk of flooding when a landslide blocked the Kali Gandaki River
